Karmic Debt

(Karmic Debt... This number will probably be one of the hardest lessons for you to learn. Mostly, because even if you know and comprehend the *theory*, ONLY LIVING the experience, your GRAND BREAKING POINT, will give you what you truly need--- REAL UNDERSTANDING. In the case of your Personal Road Map, *Karmic Debt* is the ability you gain to actually DRIVE the car in unfavorable conditions; knowing to anticipate another driver's bad decisions so as not to collide with them, or knowing what to do when driving through fog or on icy roads.

Just like becoming a good driver, TRUE *Karmic Debt* comprehension will come once you've been "driving" for a while and that's only IF you were actually paying attention and not getting distracted by loud music, good conversations, or great weed, etc.

So in essence, KNOWING your *Karmic Debt* and how it will affect you is like getting your Driver's License. Yes, you CAN legally drive, but that doesn't make you proficient. It's the experience that makes you WORTHY of BEING a driver.

*To find your *Karmic Debt Number*, add up all number values in your name (and also double check your other **core numbers** (Life Path, Birth Day, Heart's Desire/Soul's Urge, and/or Personality Number) from previous lessons). If BEFORE the FINAL BREAKDOWN of the numbers (before you break it down to a single digit) you have either **13, 14, 16, or 19**, then you do in fact, have a *Karmic Debt* and can/should proceed with this lesson.

*Let's use the name example we've been using, Graham Wilbur Boxworth and add up all the numbers:

Graham Wilbur Boxworth

791814 593239 26656928

"Almost final" number is 15 which would be where we would break it down by adding 1+5 to get 6. But that's NOT what we're going to do. We STOP at 15. And because of this, our Fictional Mr. Boxworth has **NO KARMIC DEBT because 15 is NOT a Karmic Debt Number** (Yes, in the other core numbers he also doesn't have it, I checked) so technically, (he) could skip this lesson. If you are like our fictional Mr. Boxworth, and have **NO KARMIC DEBT**, you too, can skip this lesson. But, I urge you to revisit one of your more difficult lessons, prior.
